She grew up in the tiny Netherlands so her first language is Dutch. She was introduced to English, French and German during her high school education there, arriving in Australia with her family not long after her 16th birthday. She learned Indonesian briefly over 20 years ago here in Perth and had the opportunity to utilise the language 'live' during visits to Indonesia in 1997 and 1999.
