

# KELMSCOTT HOMESCHOOL GROUP PRIMARY SCHOOL ART (ages 5-10)

## Term 1, 2018

**Requirements:** . Children to wear a paint shirt each week.

Lessons for the upper primary aged students will give a wide variety of experiences for the children to enjoy, and will develop their learning of different skills and techniques. We will also be focussing on the character quality of responsibility. This term, we will complete eight different art projects, including:

- Radial design monoprint
- Picasso art game
- Origami with drawn eye design
- Watercolour dandelion with masked areas
- Moving line collage
- Pizza box party
- Colour-bleed coaster set
- Circular paper sculpture

In creating these art pieces, the children will learn a great deal about art as a subject, and the skills of art in practice. Below I have listed skills and knowledge they will experience this term.

- Elements of art
  - Creative application of elements using random input
  - Drawing to specifications
  - Realistic drawing of the eye, through observation
  - Choosing colours that create a desired effect
  - Perceiving different emotional qualities of basic lines
  - Manipulating line for interesting effect
  - Working within restricted colour schemes
  - Creation of three-dimensional object from two dimensions
- Principles of design
  - Investigation of radial symmetry
  - Creating movement with line
  - Artistic decision-making using design elements
  - Defining a design using black outline and white highlight
  - Creation of a striking design
- Use of materials
  - Monoprint technique

- Use of oil pastels
- Fine motor skills of paper folding
- Use of masking fluid in watercolour painting
- Watercolour techniques: wet in wet, salt texture, determining correct wetness of paper
- Creative colour method using sharpies and alcohol
- Precise cutting and gluing skills
- Art appreciation
  - Study of great artist's work
  - Listening to and following detailed instructions
  - Creating a useful and attractive gift item
