Overview:

Week 1

Cattle: beef, dairy

Students will glue photographs into their book, complete a resource book from dairy.com.au & use supermarket catalogues during this lesson

Week 2

Pigs: pork, leather

Kangaroos: meat, leather

Students will glue photographs and samples of pig, kangaroo, lamb, and cow leather, and use supermarket catalogues during this lesson

Week 3

Poultry: meat, eggs

Students will glue photographs into their book, and use supermarket catalogues during this lesson.

Week 4

Fish: aquaculture, and pearls

Students will glue photographs into their book, use supermarket catalogues and make their own pearl during this lesson.

Week 5

Wheat

Rice

Students will glue photographs and wheat & rice samples into their books, and use supermarket catalogues during this lesson.

Week 6

Fruit

Veges

The importance of bees

Students will glue photographs into their books, and use supermarket catalogues during this lesson.

Week 7

Cotton

Students will glue photographs and samples of cotton materials into their books, and make the stages of a cotton plant using cardboard and cotton wool.
